The second firefighter bunkroom at Station 1 is set up and in use. This bunkroom brings the sleeping facilities up to 8 beds at Station 1 and allows female firefighters on duty to have a bunkroom. The bunk bed for this room was provided by the Firefighter's Association. The crew is also working on repainting the interior of Station 1 thanks to a generous donation and the paint sale at Sender's Market.

Two new volunteer firefighters applied in August. These two new firefighters are going through the application process and will start the Calaveras County Firefighter Academy in January. Central Fire has two new Water Tender Operators who will be attending the Calaveras County Driver Operator academy, also in January.

Limited Term Fire Captains (SAFER Grant): Central Calaveras Fire's Lieutenant Cody Stephens and Firefighter / Engineer Chris Decoque have been hired for the Limited Term Fire Captain Positions. The first day of the new schedule is September 27th.

Fire Chief's Report January 2015

Our Annual Volunteer Recognition Dinner is going to be held on Friday February 6th at 6:00 PM. The Mountain Ranch Community Club is helping recognize our volunteers by hosting the event in conjunction with their monthly potluck.

The Fire Chief will be in Baltimore, Maryland the 2nd week of January. The Chief was selected to be an evaluator for the Assistance to Firefighters grant program by FEMA.

Water Tender 124 (1992 International - 1200 gallons) is now in service and responding out of Station 4 in Glencoe. Engine 124 (1970 International Engine) has been removed from service. The Chief is recommending that the Board of Directors declare the vehicle as surplus and sell the vehicle. In December, Engines 121 and 122 had their annual maintenance and pump tests completed. New Tires were also put on E121. Engine 123 had a turbo intercooler hose replaced under warranty by Ford. All of the District's apparatus are currently in service.

Central Fire has 6 members attending the Calaveras County Emergency Medical Responder class in January. Once complete, these members will be able to respond on Medical Aid calls as First Responders. The Fire Chief is the primary instructor for this class.

Two firefighters are attending the Driver / Operator Class in Copperopolis. Once completed, these firefighters will be able to get their Firefighter endorsement from the DMV to operate fire apparatus. Central Fire has one new volunteer firefighter that will be attending the Calaveras County Firefighter Academy starting in February.

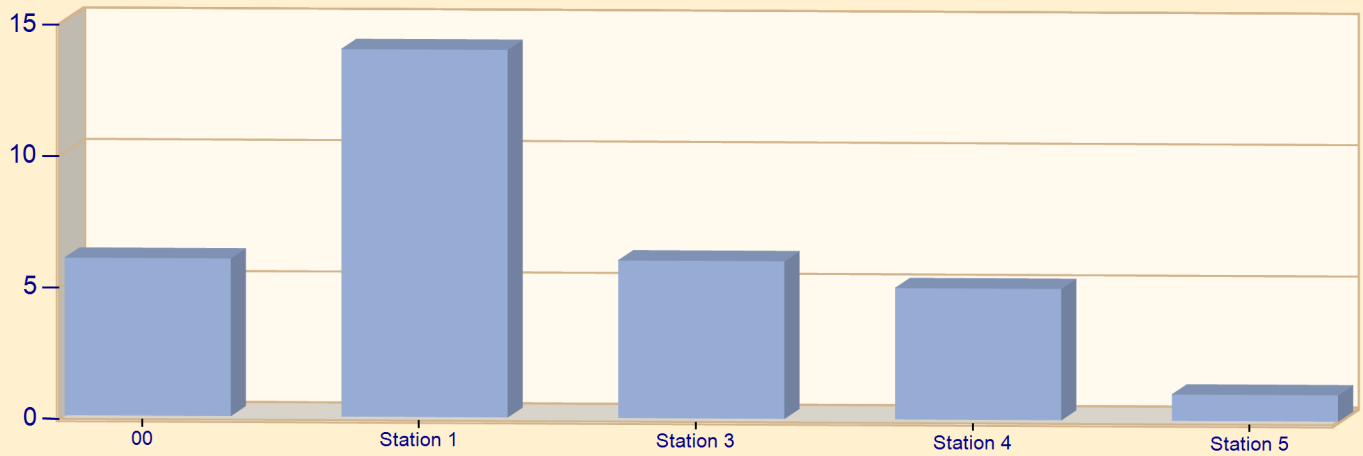
