Facilities Report September 2017

Inspection Results by Facilities Manager:

Station 3: Termites found in exterior wall. I had expected to find a minor intrusion, but instead found the results of a long time issue. I did not find any live termites, as the wood has dried out from the rainy season. What I did find was that four main studs, including the window trimmers had been eaten to the point where they no longer supported the wall. This happened through a combination of earth to wood exposure, flooding, and a minor roof leak.

I have temporarily tacked up the old siding to secure the building. All of the sheetrock has been removed from the wall. I have replaced half of the damaged lumber. On my next work day, I will repair the other damaged lumber, replace approximately 60 sq.ft. of siding and treat wall with copper chemical to prevent future infestation. I will follow up by replacing some of the insulation and all of the sheetrock on that wall. I estimate a total of at least three and a half total days of labor on this repair. I arranged for Clark Pest Control to give us a free termite report on the building, on September 27th, I believe. Not sure of the date. I will address roof leaks, once the weather is cooler.

Station 2: At a routine station cleaning, I went up on the roof to clean the gutters. While up there, I observed several holes in the roofing material along the overhangs. Most of these holes I believe are the work of Woodpeckers. There are several places where shingles have broken off, and in my opinion the roof needs to be replaced. Patching may buy us one more winter. On further inspection we discovered that there had been termite intrusion in the wood members which support the garage door headers at the center. This could only have happened if water is leaking down from the roof. I will at my soonest convenience go back and expose the wall at the base to ensure that the studs still bear weight. In addition, there are six lookout beams which support the gable overhangs, and they are rotted hollow. I recommend cutting those back and treating them or replacement if wood is too damaged. Lastly, the water pipe to the hose bibs is leaking. I propose adding a shut off valve closer to building before exacting repairs. I will meet with property owner to set this up.
